The Mission of the North Christian School Board is

To continually improve the Spirituality, Academics, and Environment of North Christian School to better meet the needs of our students and their families.

The School Board shall

- Set the Spiritual, Academic, and Environmental tone for the school in accordance with the overall vision and mission of the Senior Pastor and Advisory Board
- Lead the development and review of the specific goals for each Focus Area (Spiritual, Academic, and Environmental, Students, Families)
- Periodically review the performance in these focus areas
- Develop and implement action plans to improve these focus areas
- Assist in the development of school policies and procedures to ensure that they are consistent with the vision for each focus area

General Board Member Responsibilities

Each Board Member will

- Attend a minimum of one regularly scheduled Board Meeting per month
- Attend any required non regularly scheduled Board Meeting
- Work on action items and plans outside of regularly scheduled Board Meetings
- Attend school functions

General Board Member Requirements

Each Board Member

- Must be a Born-again believer in Jesus Christ.
- Must subscribe without reservation to the School's Statement of Faith and Philosophy of Education.
- Shall be a member of a Bible-believing church and demonstrate faithfulness in attendance and be actively involved in ministry.
- Must have life experience and/or college degree in the associated area of discipline or equivalent (detailed requirements are listed in the Areas of Discipline Listed below)
- Must not be a full-time employee or spouse of any full-time employee of North Christian School shall be eligible to serve on the Board. (voting members only)

BOARD MAKE-UP:

The Board is made up of five voting members from the Areas of Disciplines listed below. The Board is facilitated by a Board President that votes in the case of a tie. In addition to the voting members, the School Principal, Church Administrator, and Senior Pastor (optional) participate in Board activities.

Each member serves on the Board for a term of three years, unless such service is terminated by resignation, death or dismissal. Any Board member is eligible to be considered for a second successive three-year term.

AREAS OF DISCIPLINE:

DISCIPLINE	RESPONSIBILITIES	SPECIFIC MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
LEGAL	Responsible for providing guidance to ensure that NCS operates within applicable legal guidelines.	Life experience and/or Legal Degree
MARKETING	Responsible for developing and executing NCS marketing plan for the purpose of increasing enrollment. Responsible for managing fund raising programs including grant writing.	Life experience and/or B.S., B.A in Marketing, Finance, or other applicable Business Management discipline
SECURITY	Responsible for the safety and security of NCS.	Life experience and/or B.S., B.A. in Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement Officer
BUSINESS LAW	Responsible for providing guidance to ensure that NCS operates within applicable financial and tax guidelines.	Life experience and/or CPA, B.S., B.A in Accounting (or equivalent Business discipline)
SPIRITUAL WELFARE	Responsible for the spiritual welfare of the Students, Staff, and School Board	Life experience and/or B.S., B.A. in Social Services, Counseling, or Divinity

SELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS:

Each Board Member candidate shall submit the Board Member Application to the school office. The Board will review the applications and select candidates for a Board interview. Candidates will be approved by a Board vote.

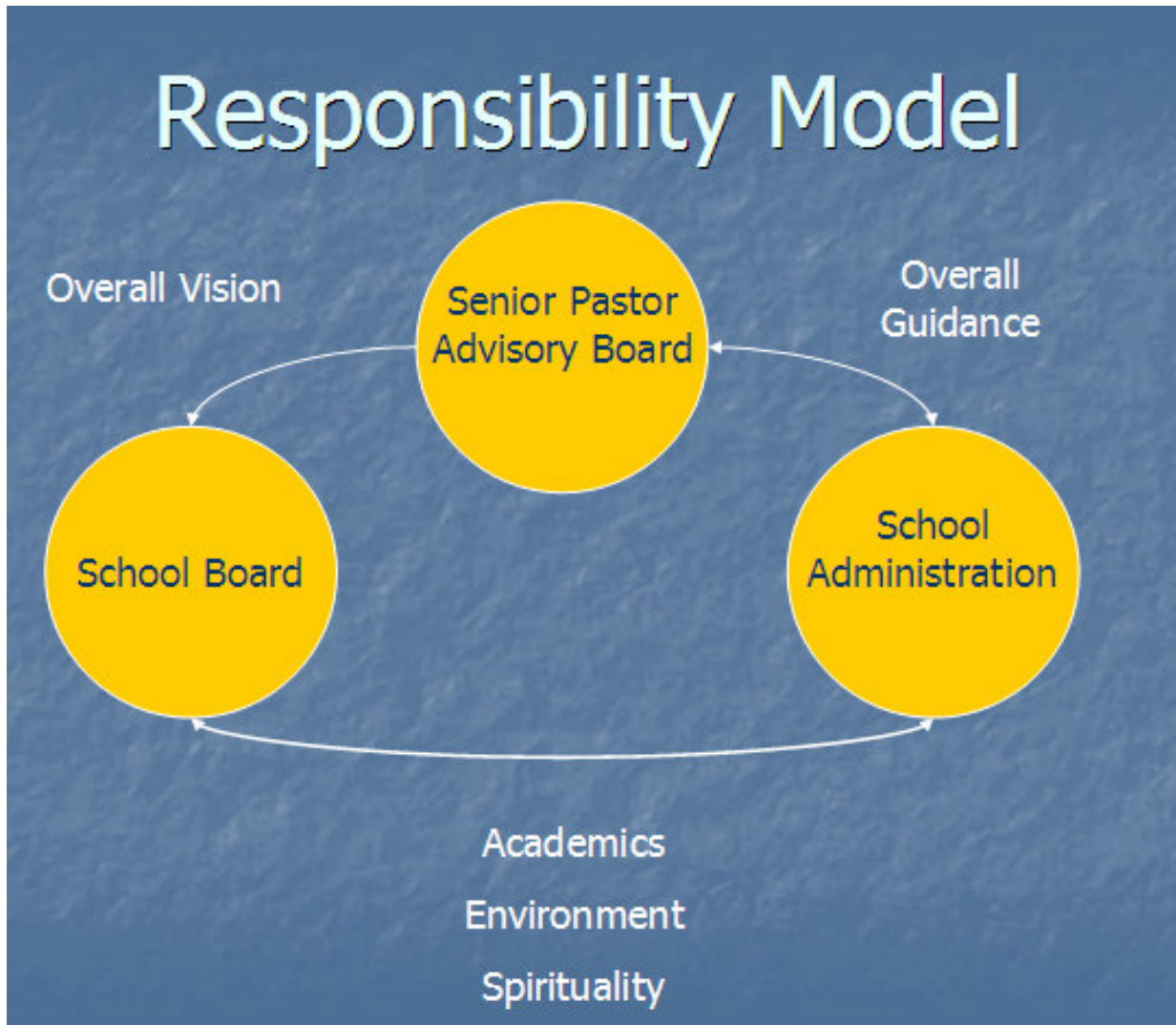
MEETING SCHEDULE:
